

**NORTH FRANKLIN TOWNSHIP**

**Resolution No. 13 of 2020**

**RESOLUTION OF THE NORTH FRANKLIN TOWNSHIP  
BOARD OF SUPERVISORS, WASHINGTON COUNTY,  
PENNSYLVANIA, FIXING THE REAL ESTATE TAX LEVY AT  
A RATE OF 1.25 MILLS BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 2021.**

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Supervisors of North Franklin Township pursuant to its powers set forth in the Municipalities Planning Code (See §1010 *et seq.*), and the Pennsylvania Second Class Township have the authority to fix the real estate tax rate in the Township; and

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the North Franklin Township Board of Supervisors at a Public Meeting held on December 8, 2020, voted to levy on all real property within the Township, a tax rate for general purposes of 1.25 mills on each dollar of assessed valuation, being further described as \$0.00125 on each dollar of assessed valuation. Said rate shall take effect on January 1, 2021; and


**ALSO RESOLVED**, that any resolution, or part of resolution conflicting with this resolution be repealed insofar as the same is inconsistent and affects this resolution; and


**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Secretary of North Franklin Township is directed to execute a certificate attesting to the adoption of this resolution and to maintain a copy of the resolution within the North Franklin Township Municipal Office and posted on the Township website when possible, as well as provide a copy to the Township Tax Collector.
