PLEASE BRING ITEMS FOR DISPOSAL ONLY ON SCHEDULED COLLECTION DAYS. ANYONE LEAVING ITEMS ON SITE ON NON-EVENT DAYS ARE ILLEGALLY DUMPING, AND IF CAUGHT WILL BE PROSECUTED. NO DUMPING SIGNS WILL ALSO BE INSTALLED ON SITE AS WELL AS SURVEILLANCE EQUIPMENT.

JVS Environmental PERMANENT ELECTRONICS RECYCLING FACILITY is located at 1 American Way, Ellsworth, PA 15331. The site is located behind the Ellsworth Post Office (1002 Almond Road, Ellsworth, PA 15331). Participants will enter the site from Almond Road, past the Beer Here Beer Distributor. JVS Environmental will be managing the site. This site will replace the monthly electronics collection program that was previously held at the Washington County Fairgrounds, then at the Washington Mall site.

The site will be open on the 2nd and 4th Tuesday of each month from 2 p.m. to 6 p.m. Here are the dates for 2021:
